MGT (Motorbike Gospel Team)



27-28 August we went to Chiangrai Province and distributed 100 sets of picture books and audio CDs of GRN's Look Listen and Live 1 and 2 in the Black Lahu language. The distribution was done in a village 5 hours from Chiangmai where the villagers get a small amount of electricity via solar cell. The people have to be very resourceful using the electricity so that they will have enough for the evening hours. The couple in one home where we visited listened diligently to the recording and told us that they want to learn more about God so they can share accurately with their neighbors. The man's son in law said that he likes to evangelize in the village when the people are doing their ceremonies. Praise God. May God strengthen this couple. While we were in the village, the man played our recordings loudly. I'm sure many villagers heard them clearly.



4-5 September we visited the Lawa people in the village where Boy's fiancé comes from. We did Love Touch for many people and played mp3 Gospel recordings in the Lawa language for many to hear. Many listened carefully. This village is about 15% Christian.

15-19 October Boy and I had a great opportunity to go with a team from Wycliffe Thailand to the city of Chiang Tung in the country of Myanmar. Our purpose was to research the culture and lifestyle of the people there and that the Thai people will have a burden to serve and minister cross culturally. We visited a Lahu Bible School and a church of the Plang people group. We had a wonderful time on this trip. Boy and I both got to see the lifestyle of the people in this country that borders Thailand and we also were blessed to see the strong faith of believers there.



4-5 November we went to visit a Karen Sgaw Christian worker in his village. He had contacted us and asked us to come. He is the only Christian in the village which is located in a valley. Travel to this village is difficult and it takes about 9 hours to travel the 250 kilometers to get there. The village uses solar cell to generate electricity. We trust that in the future God will bring His Gospel to this village through the one lone believer.



I thank the Lord and you all very much for your prayer for us. In the last email, I asked you to pray for me about the motorbikes we had. They are not safe for us. Please pray for us to have money to buy safer new motorbikes for us. Our friends purchased the Honda CRF 250. We tried it and found out it is much safer to drive.
